While attending UTA, Doug worked loader, sorter, and ultimately part-time supervisor for United Parcel Services. Upon graduating with a Bachelor of Business Administration – Finance, he continued his career with UPS and was transferred to New Orleans, Louisiana where he was in charge of the Accounting Department for the Louisiana District. In 1989, Doug left UPS and purchased an automotive collision repair business in Fort Worth, which he ultimately sold in a roll up to Craig's Collison. Since 1999, Doug has successfully started and managed several businesses. In 2005, he co-founded DEMA Partners, a real estate development company with Derek DeGuire. DEMA Partners has current development projects in Southlake and Argyle, Texas.



Doug pledged Delta Upsilon in Spring 1978. He was Treasurer in **Don Dyer '79'**s administration. In November of 1979, he was elected President.

What made you decide to pledge Delta U?

John Daniel '82 and myself rushed in the fall of our freshman year and checked out most of the fraternities on campus. Back when dinosaurs roamed the earth, the legal drinking age was 18 so we thought we would take full advantage of all the free parties. We were going to wait until our sophomore year to pledge but during Spring rush some of the more senior members of our beloved DU chapter separated us and played John and I against one another. They were telling us "your buddy is going to pledge and you don't want to be a pledge when he is an active do you?" The next day at bid house, after we got our minds and stories sorted out, we were like, "what tha...?" Overall it worked out great.

We put on several rush clinics and learned to "bump rush." It paid off, that spring we recruited the largest pledge class by far among all the other fraternities.

That Spring class you mention was a little older group, no freshman, with lots of personalities so were they a pain in the a..?

That class made up approximately 40% of our chapter membership. For the first month or so everything was fine. **John Cooper '80** was the Pledge Trainer and he raised them like kids are raised today, with way too much self-esteem. The Exec had to put them back in line from time to time.

Do you still get together with brothers from your time?

I see several of the old timers once a year or so.

Do you think your experiences in Delta Upsilon has benefited you in the business world?

I have always credited my DU experiences with helping me in my career. You truly do get out what you put in.
