## **President – Carl Esposito**

- A. Executive Board met in early March to go over goals and discuss new positions
- B. Discussed how to drive membership in the alumni organization
  - Will be led by Brothers Esposito, Sawyer, and Jordan
  - Will create an annual budget starting this year
  - Need a plan by September to have available for potential dues paying members
- C. Brief synopsis of Housing situation
  - Ideas previously discussed by the Board
    - o Build a new house on campus
      - 1. Architect plans were drawn up years ago; cost to build was approximately \$625,000
    - o Work with the University for other options
      - 1. Clubhouse concept
        - a. Option 1: have just a library, kitchen, common room, etc., but no living quarters
        - b. Option 2: have living quarters only for the top 2-4 executive board members
        - c. If we go with option 1, need to preserve the right to expand later on to possibly build on living quarters
        - d. Cannot put a price on the bonding that living with multiple people provides; the brotherhood aspect is immeasurable
        - e. Cash flowing the house has always been an issue; need to be careful here
      - 2. Greek village concept
        - a. Individual chapters rent sectioned off residence halls
        - b. Share central court yard, barbecue, and volleyball space
      - 3. Purchase an existing house close to campus
        - a. Build on the side of campus that the University is not expanding for longevity
        - b. Build on the side of campus that the University is expanding, and plan on getting bought out at some point
      - 4. Rent some apartments in the retail space near campus
        - a. Could get a discount from the landlord as an incentive to fill the vacant space

- B. Golf tournament
  - Scheduled for May 1<sup>st</sup> at Rolling Hills Country Club
  - Preliminary plans:
    - o Alumni tee times at \$75 each
    - o Active tee times at \$55 each
    - o Red balls \$10 each (able to tee off from the ladies tee box)
    - o Mulligans \$5 each
    - o Strings \$10 each
    - o Sponsorships tee boxes \$50, fairways \$50, and greens \$50
    - o Approximate total income of \$5,320, expenses of \$1,831.31, and net income of \$3,488.69
  - Typically the proceeds go to chapter scholarships
  - This year some of the proceeds will be used for ADUF working capital
- C. Ducks on the Pond
  - Active chapter has reserved the intramural softball field for April 24<sup>th</sup>
  - Add to New Business: discuss moving the event to a Saturday in September close to Rush
- D. Anniversary celebration
  - Nothing formal this year, mention it at the golf tournament
- E. Canoe trip
  - Active chapter is interested in having it in June this year
  - Active chapter would like an option for alumni to prepay
- F. Happy Hours
  - Next one is June 30<sup>th</sup>
- G. Turkey bowl
  - Will discuss location next meeting
- H. Storage
  - Arlington has a shortage of climate controlled storage
  - Brother Will thinks the best option is the U-Haul self-storage on Bowman street
  - Move to new business to vote on
- I. Master calendar and event notifications
  - Need a master calendar for ADUF; Brother McCaghren and Brother Jordan will work together on this
  - Brother Jordan and Brother McCaghren will coordinate on event notifications
- J. Agendas/Minutes
  - Would like to have agendas prepared and distributed well before each meeting
    - Officer reports and agenda items will be due to the President 7 days before each meeting
    - Brother Esposito will consolidate all officer reports and agenda items post the agenda to the website and the Facebook group 7 days prior to each Board meeting
